



On August 24th, East Gwillimbury Emergency & Community Safety Services received a grant of \$20,334 the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation to fund the purchase of 550 guidelights. In the event of an emergency, the awarded lights will emit a high intensity red strobe light clearly visible at a distance, allowing first responders to quickly locate those in need of medical assistance. This is increasingly important, as roughly 35 percent of the community's population is senior citizens, including a large portion living in rural areas.

The award was presented in conjunction with the Town of East Gwillimbury's re-opening of the Queensville Park with new fire-safety themed play equipment.
